History of Benham's Grove

Purchased by the City of Centerville in 1991, Benham's Grove sits on 8.6 acres of property that once part of a 50-acre farm by Aaron Nutt, one of the city's founders. Benham's Grove serves our community as a meeting facility and community gathering place available for rental.

The Friends of Benham's Grove is a volunteer organization whose purpose is to preserve and promote the expansion of the gardens at Benham's Grove and to develop special projects which will further these plans. The City Council passed a resolution on April 17, 1995 supporting the organization and its purpose.
